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About the project

PLACE AND DATE:	Tg-Jiu, 22-29.03.2020 (with 2 travel days included)
PARTICIPANTS:	8 Young people from each partner country
LANGUAGE:	The official language of the project is English

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- 8 young people/country
- Young people aged 16-20
- Good knowledge of English

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MAIN OBJECTIVE

- To promote social, educational, cultural and artistic programs for disadvantaged persons from our local communities and to increase active participation of 24 young people from the partner countries through development of a transnational youth initiative project.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT:

- Development of social participation and commitment among 24 disadvantaged young people from the partner countries through jointly creation and implementation of social-educational, cultural and artistic initiatives for disadvantaged children, youth and elderly in 3 local communities from EU;
- Development of knowledge and competencies among 24 disadvantaged young people from the partner countries specially in the field of social participation, inclusion, community development through exposing them to vulnerable social groups;
- Development of support for disadvantaged children, youth and elderly in 3 local communities from EU through 3 local activities jointly carried out by 24 young people from the partner countries.

ACTIVITIES Foreseen for the Learning teaching training activity in Romania

- Organizations presentations, team building games, project presentation and Erasmus+, cultural visit of the city
- Exchange of best practices and study visits in institutions working with disadvantaged children
- Interests / Skills / Hobbies Workshop - discovery of the interests, skills and hobbies of young participants to better identify their profile and their orientation towards different activities according to their profiles.
- Planning social and cultural activities for disadvantaged children and their implementation

Learning outcomes

- Social-personal development (exploration of volunteer skills, problem solving and group creativity, team building, conflict management, ability to communicate, relationship, respect for others' opinions, public speaking skills)

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- Developing skills for planning / implementing and evaluating volunteer activities, budget planning and resource allocation according to needs, development of ICT skills, organizational skills, coordination, analysis, self-evaluation, evaluation of learning outcomes, how to self-evaluate, how to evaluate the results of a learning

Rules and principles of the mobility

1. Answering the requirements of the sending and receiving organizations accordingly and respecting the deadlines for each task/activity
2. Attendance at mobility activities and individual activities for the preparation and follow up.
3. Following the set of rules of behavior inside the group during the mobility

Preparation of the participants for the mobility - Under the supervision and support of the sending organization and where needed receiving organization, each group of organizations will:

- Inform the participants regarding the project
- Informal workshop about the E+ and its opportunities - offering guidance to identify their learning objectives during the initial evaluation process
- Presentation of the general consideration of the mobility program and discussing each proposed activities

Task related preparation

- Presentation of their organization
- Intercultural preparation – young people will prepare for intercultural night and will be guided in a self-reflection process on this topic - participants will research together cultural information about the partner countries.

Follow-up

National groups from Portugal and Italy will replicate with the support of sending organizations the social, educational, cultural and artistic programs created for children during the mobility in Romania.

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LOGISTICS:

LOCATION OF THE ACTIVITIES:

CITY – TARGU JIU (the city is located at about 300 km far from Bucharest – capital of Romania, at 5 hours by train/bus)
Travel arrangements will be made by the hosting organization – CECIS in cooperation with the partners for each national group.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IN TG-JIU

- Buses – in Tg-Jiu there are regular buses that takes you to any poin of the city. The ticket price is 2 Ron (one way).
- Taxi – price per km is 2 RON.

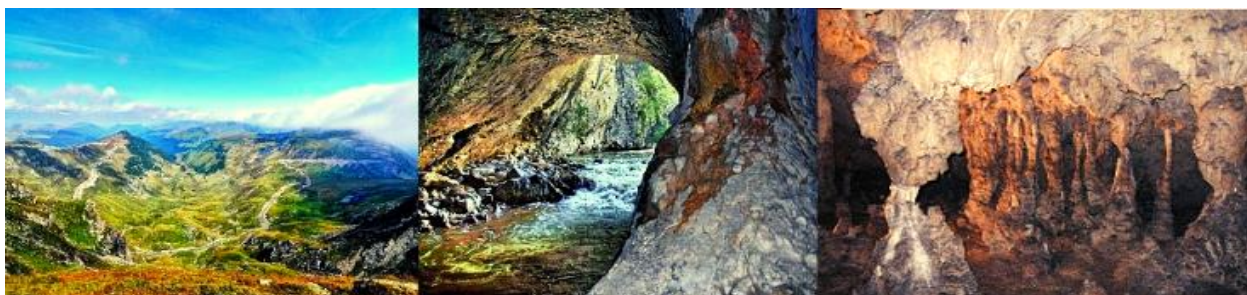

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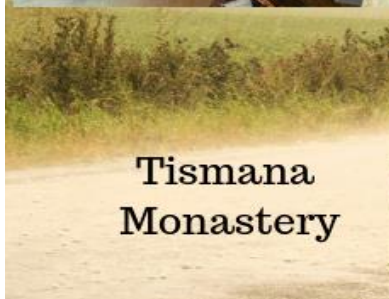
